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COVID-19 Re-Entry Screening Form for Previously III Individuals Licensed Child Care Centres and Home Child Care Providers

Instructions for Screening:

All individuals who were previously ill may return to the centre if:

- They have no new or worsening symptoms
- They are free of fever (< 37.8°C) for 24 hours
- They have consulted with a healthcare provider
- Their symptom for which they were sent home is improving
- They have been free from diarrhea and/or vomiting for 24 hours since their last episode
- A NEGATIVE COVID-19 test was received and symptoms are improving

Note: For anyone with persisting or worsening symptoms, they will not be passing screening. It is recommended that they consult with their health care provider for further assessment, including whether or not they require a COVID-19 test.

All individuals who were previously ill <u>must</u> complete the additional screening below upon return to the centre/home <u>after</u> having completed the active screening process at home.

For any individuals who have tested **positive** for COVID-19 will require direction from the Brant County Health Unit before they can return to childcare.

1. Have you [or the child] been fever-free for at least 24 hours and/or are their symptoms improving as per the above-mentioned criteria?				

If **NO** was answered for the question above, do **not** permit the individual to return to the childcare centre. The individual will need to consult with a healthcare provider and remain fever-free for at least 24 hours and with other symptoms to be improving before returning (unless there has been close contact with a confirmed COVID-19 case or symptomatic person(s), in which case the individual may not return until 14 days after last contact with the probable or confirmed COVID-19 case).

2. Have you (or your child) been recommended by a physician to get a COVID-19 test?

If YES, was the result of your test negative?				
If a test was completed and NO answered for the question above, do not permit the individual to return to the childcare centre. The individual needs to have a negative test result before returning. Proof a negative test is not required. If the physician recommended a COVID-19 test and the individual refused to be tested, they may not return for 10 days since the onset of their symptoms.

3. Have you had any close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 in the last 14 days?				
4. Have you had any close contact with a person with COVID-19 symptoms (e.g. fever, cough, shortness of breath) who is either waiting for COVID-19 test results or who has not yet been tested for COVID-19 in the last 14 days?				
If YES was answered for <u>ANY</u> of the questions in Step 3 , do not permit the individual to enter the facility. The individual will need to self-isolate for 14 days from the last time they had close contact with a probable or confirmed COVID-19 case.				
If NO was answered for <u>ALL</u> of the questions in Step 3 , proceed to Step 4 .				

Close contact is an individual being coughed or sneezed on <u>or</u> being within 2 metres of a person with COVID-19 for a minimum of 15 minutes (without PPE)

If YES was answered for ALL the questions in Step 4 , do not permit the individual to enter the childcare centre. They must self-isolate with their household.					
If NO was answered for Question 6 , proceed with conducting the active daily screening process using the appropriate tool for the staff and/or essential visitors. For any children, they can enter the childcare centre.					
If NO was answered for <u>ALL</u> of the questions in Step 4 , proceed with the validation process for the individual.					
For children whose screening results have been validated, they can enter the childcare centre.
